Thank you for your interest in the Cullen Baker Country Fair. The Fair is a one-day event on **Saturday, November 6, 2010** in Bloomburg, Texas.

The Fair is located outdoors with craft booths lining the streets of town. All booths must be set up and ready for business by 8:00 a.m. Saturday morning. Depending on the time you require, it is recommended that you arrive by 6:00 a.m., or you may set up on Friday, November 5 (see note below about location restrictions). Booths close at 5:00 p.m. at which time tear down begins. Main Street is closed to vehicles from 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. the day of the Fair.

Additional information about the Fair and booths:

- Booths are **10 x 10** and are marked and numbered on the street. Each vendor is responsible for providing their own set up, including tables, chairs, display racks, canopies, etc.
- The fee is **\$30** per booth. There are a limited number of spaces with electricity; those spaces are \$35 each. Vendors from the previous year have the option of retaining the same location this year if applications are received by October 15.
- Receipt of your application and fee will be acknowledged in September if a legible email address is provided.
- Booth assignments/numbers will be available at the City Hall on Friday, November 5 as well as Saturday morning. Volunteer firemen throughout the downtown area will also have that information and assist you in locating your assigned space
- Completed applications should be returned with the appropriate rental fee (checks payable to Bloomburg Fair Corp) by October 15, 2010. If you have a special need we will be glad to try and accommodate you if you call us by the application deadline.
- Food for consumption on the day of the Fair including soft drinks, bottled water, chips, baked goods are not to be sold by craft vendors. If you wish to sell those items complete and submit a food vendor application. Mixes, spices, oils, gift baskets including food items, etc. are acceptable items to sell from a craft booth.
- If your booth is located in front of Bloomburg Foods' parking lot you may NOT set up until after closing on Friday evening. Those spaces block their entry and are not safe either for vehicles and your equipment and merchandise.
